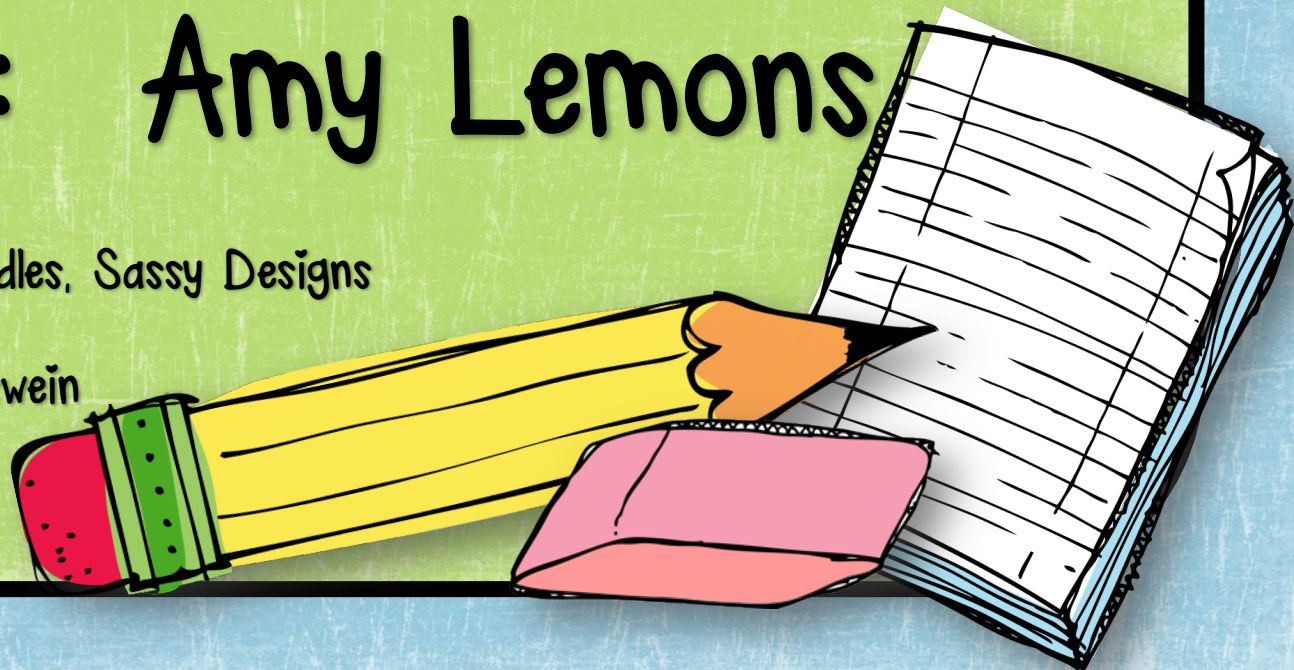

Write and Highlight

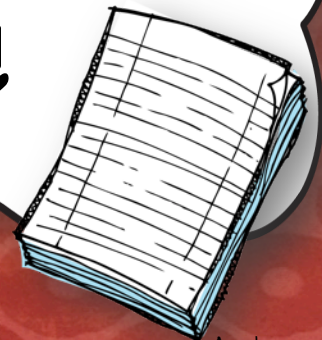
Write your words in a list. Highlight the vowels in one color.
